



COVID-19 Mitigation Plan

The following guidelines are provided in support of the EOD Warrior Foundation (EODWF) EOD Weekend events on April 30 and May 1, 2021. *The guidelines address public health protection measures for guests, staff, and volunteers.*

I. BASIC CENTER FOR DISEASE CONTROL (CDC) GUIDELINES TO BE FOLLOWED:

- Maintain social distancing of at least 6 feet at all times from others, except for members of the same household
- Wear a mask or face covering except when stationary to eat or drink
- Wash hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds; if soap and water are not readily available, use a hand sanitizer containing at least 60% alcohol
- Avoid touching eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands
- Anyone with symptoms consistent with COVID-19 (including fever, cough, or difficulty breathing) should stay home. Ball ticket refunds will be provided in this situation.

II. EODWF WILL:

- Host an event that follows state guidelines and provides outdoor space as required
- Provide physical reminders, such as signage, to encourage participants to remain at least 6 feet apart in lines for registration, check in etc.
- Ensure that:
 - Staff and volunteers at registration, check-in and food/beverage pick up areas will be wearing appropriate PPE
 - All food serving utensils including plates, napkins, silverware, etc. will be disposable, one time use
 - Food and drinks will be served by trained volunteers and staff wearing appropriate PPE
- Train all staff and volunteers to ensure all are aware of the guidelines
- Obtain a list of all guests, staff and volunteers with phone numbers and email to assist with notifications procedures and contact tracing in the event there is a positive COVID-19 case after the event

III. GUESTS & VOLUNTEERS WILL:

- Be required to wear a mask or face covering during the event except when stationary to eat or drink
- Be encouraged to use hand sanitizer when arriving and frequently throughout the event(s)
- Be encouraged to stay in small groups and with those they are familiar with throughout the event(s)

Note: Plan will be updated to reflect any changes with federal, state, or local government guidelines that are applicable as the event date nears.
