

Founded in 2013 through the merger of two separate EOD focused foundations, the EODWF (a 501(c)(3) nonprofit) provides ongoing support to the entire EOD Community through various programs. Its programs and support serve to supplement, the support already provided by the Department of Defense and Department of Veterans Affairs.

This support includes immediate and on-going financial grants, care and upkeep of the EOD Memorial at Eglin Air Force Base, educational scholarships, and personal support in the form of therapeutic healing retreats, morale events, education on resources and community connections, and peer-to-peer mentoring.
